It's been more than 150 years since founder Jacob Beringer first set sail from Germany to establish his iconic winery in Napa Valley in 1868. The history of this vaunted winery has come full circle as Jacob's great-great-grandson, Mark Beringer, now stewards the winemaking process.

In between, some highly notable winemakers have passed through the caves, and your lot features three great vintages of Beringer Vineyards Private Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon made by two of them.

A shining beacon of this storied winery's portfolio is its Benchland Select Cabernet Sauvignon, and your lot includes two cases of the lustrous 2008 vintage. Your wine was crafted from two exceptional vineyards in Napa Valley's gently sloping western benchlands, including Hill Ranch in the heart of the famed Rutherford nested appellation not far from the winery. Both sites enjoy ideal eastern exposures, well-drained soils and mild afternoon temperatures, resulting in uniform fruit ripening and wines of impressive depth and elegance.

In 2008, 60% of the Benchland Select grapes came from the Hill Ranch, with 40% from the esteemed Oakville nested appellation. The 2008 growing season started with heavy rains in the winter, along with drought conditions and frost in the spring. Coupled with heat during grape set, this reduced the size of the crop, greatly concentrating flavors. The clear and mild summer that year provided ideal conditions for the full maturation of the grapes, with the perfect balance of sugar and acidity. Your resulting wine is full of dark fruit, dark chocolate and supple oak, ending with a long, elegant finish.

While the rocky soils, steep aspects and exposed conditions are among the most challenging in California, they also produce the most structured and complex wines.

Stags' Leap Winery

Ne Cede Malis

Ne Cede Malis (Latin for "don't give in to misfortune" and pronounced Nay KAY-deh Mah-lees) was the family motto of Stags' Leap founder Horace Chase and a befitting moniker for this southern Rhïne-style wine. The old-field-blend vineyard, first planted in 1929, has survived various bears and bulls but somehow continues to give a small crop of grapes with concentrated aromas, flavors and the telltale Stags' Leap firm-but-soft structure.

Ne Cede Malis, sourced from the oldest block on the estate, is predominantly Petite Sirah, though it includes at least 15 other varieties in small amounts. Year after year, this gracefully aging block produces a small lot of wine—a truly unique field blend that simply could not be produced anywhere else.

Taking a minimalist approach, winemaker Christophe Paubert likes to say that he "guides" rather than "makes" Ne Cede Malis. The carefully tended head-trained vines in this 5-acre single block include Petite Sirah, Carignane, Mourvèdre, Grenache, Peloursin, Syrah and even Muscat and Sauvignon Blanc, among others.

After handpicking, the grapes were co-fermented, undergoing a short maceration prior to aging in American oak barrels (30% new) for 14 months. The oak's spiciness, which could overwhelm a delicate wine, is easily handled and helps enhance the strength and depth of this powerful variety.

You can experience the phenomenon of Ne Cede Malis yourself, as this lot includes a six-year vertical of six standard bottles each of the 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015 vintages.

From Calistoga to Carneros, from Coombsville to Diamond Mountain, from mountain hillsides to the valley floor, his wines speak of the singularity of the vineyards, their soils and the growing conditions of the year in which they were produced. When asked what his biggest influences are when crafting a Cabernet, Thomas says, "Well, I tend to model a Cab on all the different wines I've tasted. In the back of my brain I've got memories of past vintages I love that shape my style. Wines from the late '60s and early '70s have been a constant model."

In Thomas' wine world, it's all about creating the best.

"Wine is a documentary of so many interconnected parts - the land and its soils, the period of time in which it was grown and made, and the actions of the people dedicated to its production. It is the combination of these that make wine so interesting."

Viader's "Liquid Cashmere" shows the typicity and consistency of the estate, with its firm structure influenced by the steep and very rocky volcanic red soils of the eastern slopes of Howell Mountain, and the familiar elegance and harmony created through the combination of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc.

Your lot features a remarkable three-year vertical made up of eight standard bottles from the 2013, 2014 and 2015 vintages. But Viader also wants to share some of its collection from earlier this century.

The 2006 vintage of "V" showcases the Petit Verdot grape with its very dense, almost inky color and high natural acidity. Each year "V" is blended and aged over two years in new French oak barrels with its more recognized cousin, Cabernet Sauvignon, to express the uniqueness of the vintage. Due to the very small size of the Petit Verdot plantings, this wine will always be short on production, but long on personality.

Your 2006 3-liter is one of only a few left signed by the wine-maker.
